The monograph was approved at the session of the State University of Physical Education and Sports Senate with the financial support of the Academy of Sciences of Moldova, by participating in the announced project.

In the book which is made up of six chapters, are exposed the general principles that imply the multitude of applicative knowledge, the selection of Olympic sports trials as well as the basic regularities of children's development.

The materials of the modern scientific researches are widely treated as well as the advanced sports practice which is related to the empirical part that determines the formation of the principles, regularities and methods of selection application.

Thus, it is characterized the methodology and the criteria used in the medical and sport selection. There are analysed the issues on the theoretical principles of primary selection of children and adolescents.
